Margaret “Peg, Peggy, Mom, Mama, Mom-Mom, Grammy” Shultz Paterson, 91, passed away peacefully surrounded by her family on July 1, 2022, at her residence at Edenwald retirement community. Born on June 7, 1931, she was the daughter of the late Sherman Walleigh and Anne Neely Shultz of Philadelphia. Peg was also the loving sister of Nancy S. Stryker of Cape Coral, Fl. She was predeceased by her husband James (Jim) G. Paterson Sr. who passed away in 1997.

Peg attended Penn State University where she received a degree in education. She was a dedicated science teacher and had a natural curiosity about the world around her. She has been a member of Ashland Presbyterian Church since 1966 where her servant heart flourished in many areas particularly congregational care and special music. Peg met her late husband, Jim, at Penn State and they were married in 1953.
