Peggy Ann Via passed away peacefully on January 14th, 2025 after a long battle with multiple sclerosis she was 75. radio. She was unwavering with her support of the Orioles, Baltimore Colts, and Navy Football where her father and two brothers proudly served their country.

Peggy enjoyed spending time with her beloved German shepherd, Mandy, reading and practicing her faith at St. Dominic's Church in Hamilton, where she was the Director of Religious Education for adults and children of the parish. For the last 13 years Peggy was a resident at Towson Rehabilitation and Healthcare Center (formerly HCR ManorCare-Towson) where she received full-time nursing care.

She will be remembered for never complaining or feeling sorry for herself and for her faith in God and love of family.
